### **UNM Foundation Board of Trustees Announces 2010-2011 Officers**

The UNM Foundation Board of Trustees has elected the following officers for 2010-2011. Continuing officers are **Anne Yegge, chair** of the board, and **Gary Gordon, vice chair and chair elect**. Both were elected in 2009 for two-year terms. **Carl Alongi, assistant treasurer**, and **Peter Johnstone, secretary**, were elected to second one-year terms in their respective offices. Brief bios on these officers are as follows:

- **Yegge** retired from the City of Albuquerque as director of community services after serving in several other positions in state and local government, including budget director for the city. After retiring she worked as a government and education consultant as well as in municipal bond underwriting. Yegge has served on a number of national and local boards and commissions.
- **Gordon** is treasurer at Albuquerque Academy. Previously he was an attorney at Miller Stratvert P.A. He is a New Mexico Bar Foundation fellow and an American Board of Trial Advocates member.
- **Alongi** is currently serving as a senior consultant with REDW The Rogoff Firm. His area of expertise is in business valuation, litigation support and asset management. He joined REDW in the summer of 2009 after a 20-year career at Albuquerque-based accounting firm Pulakos & Alongi, Ltd., CPAs, during which time he served as co-founder and managing shareholder. In 2001, Alongi became a financial advisor for an affiliated entity, CPA Wealth Advisors, LLC, which merged with REDW Stanley in 2009.
- **Johnstone** practices law in Albuquerque. He has served as president of the Albuquerque Bar Association, which honored him with the Outstanding Lawyer Award in 1991. He is also a member of the State Bar of New Mexico.

Additionally, **Laura Hueter Bass, John Cordova** and **Carl Alongi** were all elected to second terms on the board. Anne Yegge and Michael Emerson were elected to third terms. **Thelma Domenici, Bernie Butterfield** and **Maralyn Budke** (posthumous) were elected as emeriti trustees.

The terms of three UNM Foundation trustees have ended. Dorothy Rainosek, Lou Weller and Sonnet McKinnon served on the board for 12, 8 and 4 years, respectively.
